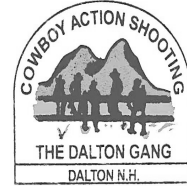

The 14th Annual Dalton Gang Primitive Biathlon

February 18th and 19th, 2017

This past year we lost a long time Dalton Biathlon participant, Ken Gaudette, known to the Dalton Biathlon volunteers as simply, "Elvis". We would like to invite you to participate in this year's Dalton Gang Primitive Biathlon, dedicated this year in his honor, we will miss him...

The event involves the use of traditional, and modern in-line muzzle loading rifles or handguns, all single shot. Wooden snowshoes must be used with or without crampons, for the traditional categories. The course is approximately 1-1/2 miles and can be enjoyed by the average participant, while some choose to run the course, many select to walk the hilly course (but the targets are big, and the Clubhouse, warm...). Along the wilderness trek will be three shooting areas. At each shooting area participants will load and fire two shots at designated targets. At the finish will be the fourth, open shooting area where participants will shoot three additional shots. All nine shots, including the finish line area will be "on the clock". All shooting will be from a standing position, unaided by shooting sticks or other external aids. We will again be using large square steel 'gong-type' targets scoring either hit or miss. A misfire will be considered a miss. Scoring times will be adjusted based on shooting scores putting an emphasis on accuracy. The final shooting area will be open to spectators and families of the participants to watch.

This event will be held regardless of the weather. In the event there is insufficient snow for snowshoes, please bring good walking boots.

This year following your suggestions, we have expanded the age categories, included a pistol category and will also be offering a 50/50 "Bull's Eye" side event.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$10.00 in advance, \$15.00 day of event – If you wish results to be mailed to you, include an extra \$1.00.

Trophies and ribbons will be awarded to Traditional rifle and pistol muzzleloaders that observe the following restrictions:

- ❑ Single-barrel traditional style muzzleloader rifles and handguns (excludes in-line)
- ❑ No optical sights
- ❑ Round ball ammunition requested – no jacketed bullets permitted
- ❑ Traverse the course with firearm unloaded while using traditional wooden snowshoes
- ❑ Observe the instructions of the event officials
- ❑ Slings used only for carrying your firearm
- ❑ Bullet boards and paper cartridges allowed; no speed loaders allowed

Trophies will be awarded to the top male and female finishers as well as ribbons for 2nd through 3rd place, as well as first smoothbore (no rear site), first in the pistol category, first junior (under sixteen), first male senior and first woman senior (60 and over) and first male and female in the “over 70” category.

Ribbons will be awarded to Modern and/or In-Line muzzleloaders that observe the following restrictions:

- ◇ No jacketed bullets or sabots allowed
- ◇ Traverse the course with firearm unloaded and may use modern snowshoes
- ◇ Observe the instruction of the event officials

Period dress is encouraged, not required. In the event of a question regarding rules, regulations, or results, the decision of the organizer is final.

EVENT DIRECTIONS: I-93 north or south to exit 43, Rte 135 north to Dalton, NH 7.7 miles from I-93 right on Union Rd to Miller Rd, follow event signs.
